About Wernicke-Korsakoff syndrome

Wernicke-Korsakoff Syndrome (WKS) is a neurodegenerative disorder that is caused by a severe thiamine (vitamin B1) deficiency Parts of the brain may be damaged as a result of this deficiency, causing increased difficulty with memory, movement, vision and coordination Most cases of WKS result from heavy alcohol

Scientists don't know exactly how many people have Korsakoff syndrome alone, but it's estimated that Wernicke-Korsakoff syndrome occurs in 1% to 2% of the general population in the United States It's widely considered less common than Alzheimer's disease, vascular dementia, frontotemporal dementia or dementia with Lewy bodies
